

### Confidence, skills and opportunities push WJHA student athlete to postsecondary success

Savan had never laced up a pair of hockey skates until his first practice with the Winnipeg Jets Hockey Academy (WJHA). Back then he was a shy kid from Cambodia who barely knew anything about hockey, let alone who had ever skated. Fast forward eight years later, and Savan had become an honour role student, team leader, talented hockey player, and a WJHA graduate.

The WJHA is one of three True North Youth Foundation (TNYF) programs designed to empower youth potential within our community. As well as providing opportunity for Canadian newcomers like Savan to engage in their new community, the WJHA helps students from socially and economically challenged neighbourhoods to better connect with their school and maintain attendance and grades. Camp Manitou, a year-round recreation facility, and Project 11, a school-based mental wellness program, round out the TNYF's youth programs.

When reflecting on his time in the WJHA, Savan is grateful for the opportunities and relationships that helped form the person he is today.

"I've made countless memories in the WJHA which I will always remember throughout my life," said Savan. "Your potential can become endless with the right opportunities and guidance given by the people around you."

The WJHA created a welcoming environment that allowed Savan to excel in school and hockey, and with the support of his coaches and teammates he grew his confidence to try new things and step out of his comfort zone, exceeding his own expectations of himself. "The WJHA provides encouragement, mentoring and opportunity that push kids to grow socially, emotionally and physically," said WJHA Director, Murray Cobb. "The goal is for our student athletes to learn important values, skills and traits that will help them beyond the game, to excel in school and in their community for life."

Despite not knowing much about hockey when he entered the WJHA, Savan was dedicated and determined and went on to play on a WJHA minor hockey team – something that wouldn't have been possible for him without the program's financial support. This experience also helped him make his high school hockey team at Transcona Collegiate where he continued to grow his confidence and his leadership skills. Savan's character and work ethic on and off the ice, earned him the WJHA Jets Alumni & Friends scholarship. While the scholarship is meant to inspire students to take what they learned in the WJHA beyond high school, Savan was already inspired and full of ambition. He is now in his second year of studies at the University of Manitoba in pursuit of a degree in Computer Science, thanks to his time in the program.

Like many WJHA grads inspired by their own program coaches and mentors, Savan stays connected to the TNYF through his job at Camp Manitou where he can be a part of other kids' positive experiences.

Without coaches who would run the after-school activities and encourage me to attend, I wouldn't have the job I have. I fell in love with the game of hockey, especially playing with friends who I built relationships with. The WJHA has given me this opportunity and I couldn't be the person I am today without it.
